## Section 1. The Council finds:

- Approximately 36,000 feet of combined sewer pipe in the Hollywood and Grant Park 1. neighborhoods, between NE Fremont St, Interstate 84, NE 33rd Ave, and NE 57th Ave are in severely deteriorated condition and need to be replaced or rehabilitated.
- 2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for replacing or rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe, including sewer manholes and service laterals.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$9,000,000. Level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2015 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10384

- The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract for the purpose described in a. Section 1, with the lowest responsive bidder.
- The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer b. System Operating Fund Budget.
