

**ORDINANCE NO. 187101**

Authorize a grant to Elders in Action for Arts Education and Access Income Tax outreach in an amount not to exceed \$8,750 (Ordinance).

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. Council finds:

1. The City of Portland Arts Education and Access Income Tax (Arts Tax) was approved by Portland voters in November of 2012. The Revenue Division of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services, the administrator of the Arts Tax, is aware of the impacts of the tax and the related filing requirements on the elder community and is seeking ways to mitigate these impacts.
2. Elders in Action (EiA) is a local non-profit whose mission is “to assure a vibrant community through the active involvement of older adults.” EiA seeks to provide worthwhile volunteer and service opportunities to its members while delivering civic engagement and educational opportunities to the public and business community.
3. EiA submitted a proposal to provide outreach services related to the tax year 2014 filing season. These services include material development, review and distribution. These services also include volunteer coordination, training, media outreach and coordination with Multnomah County and the Revenue Division. The proposal requests reimbursement of costs related to the outreach services, which includes 196 hours of staff time and \$1,250 in out-of-pocket expenses.
4. The Office of Management and Finance has budgeted funds earmarked for general outreach and has determined that the EiA outreach proposal would be an appropriate use of these funds.

Section 2. NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a grant agreement with Elders in Action, for the purpose described in Section 1, in an amount not to exceed \$8,750.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the General Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
