

ORDINANCE No. 187112 As Amended

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University for \$35,000 for development of an evaluation plan to assess the work and effect of the Community and Police Relations Subcommittee (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Council accepted a grant in the amount of \$49,921 from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services 2013 Community Policing Development – Micro Grants Program on June 4th, 2014.
2. \$35,000 of this grant award is designated for program expenses related to a research partnership with Portland State University for development of an evaluation plan to assess the work and effect of the Community and Police Relations Subcommittee.
3. The IGA is valid through the lifetime of the grant award and shall expire on September 30, 2015.
4. Portland State University has provided similar analysis and evaluation services for the Police Bureau in the past and is well-suited to provide such services on this project.
5. At this time it is beneficial to enter into an agreement with Portland State University to meet the City's needs.

NOW, therefore, the Council directs:


- a. That the Chief of Police and Auditor of the City of Portland are hereby authorized to execute an agreement between Portland State University and the City of Portland, Portland Police Bureau as detailed in the IGA attached as exhibit A.
- b. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to execute any subsequent amendments to this agreement, provided such agreements do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any agreements or modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because of critical deadlines in the grant process and to prevent any additional delay in the work to be performed through this agreement. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
