Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This ordinance will close OMF Risk Management file No. 2014 001548 30, which arises from property damage resulting from a motor vehicle accident on August 30, 2014 on NE MLK and NE Lloyd.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

This legislation will have no impact on City revenue.

Cost to the City is \$7,360.30. The source of funding is the City's Insurance and Claims Fund. All cost of the settlement is in the current fiscal year. This Ordinance does not amend the budget.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This Ordinance settles a tort claim resulting from a motor vehicle accident between a Portland Fire Bureau SUV and citizen's vehicle in NE Portland. Christopher Hermann is the owner of the other involved vehicle.

No public involvement or input was sought regarding the Ordinance. The City Attorney's Office and Risk Management have concluded that it is not appropriate to have public involvement in settlement negotiations regarding tort claims or lawsuits against the City.
