ORDINANCE No. 187125

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon State Police Criminal Investigations Division for the use of Oregon Department of Justice Oregon High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area Program grant funds to reimburse the State for drug interdiction efforts on behalf of the HIDTA Interdiction Team (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau Drugs and Vice Division HIDTA Interdiction Team (HIT) provides efforts in disrupting and dismantling drug trafficking organizations in Multnomah, Washington, and Clackamas Counties by employing a multi-agency approach to significantly impact drug availability in the area;
- 2. The HIDTA programs are funded by the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) HIDTA Program through the Oregon Department of Justice (ODOJ);
- 3. The purpose of the Intergovernmental Agreement is to address payment for services provided by the Oregon State Police (OSP) Criminal Investigations Division (CID) for work performed on HIDTA cases;
- 4. The City will, with HIDTA grant funds, reimburse CID for the cost of all approved personnel and travel expenses not to exceed \$150,000 for the three active grant awards (HIDTA 2013, 2014, and 2015);
- 5. This agreement shall begin July 1, 2014, and extend through December 31, 2016, unless earlier terminated in accordance with the agreement; and
- 6. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's and State's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's and State's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
