## ORDINANCE No. 187139

Authorize a contract with AT&T Corp. for the Inner NE Sanitary Sewer Extension Project No. E10205 and the payment of \$37,667 (Ordinance)

## The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services is undertaking an approved project to extend sanitary sewers in NE Skidmore Street between NE Grand Ave and NE 6<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- 2. Part of the work involves relocation of utilities. AT&T Corp. has fiber optic conduits in NE Skidmore Street that need to be relocated in order to construct the new sanitary sewer in this street. When AT&T originally installed their conduits, they also installed conduits for the City of Portland. The City wishes to enter into a cost-sharing agreement with AT&T Corp. so that the City conduits can be relocated at the same time the AT&T Corp. conduits are relocated.
- 3. AT&T Corp. and the Bureau of Environmental Services have agreed that the City's share of the relocation cost will be \$37,667. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10205.C60.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to enter into a cost-sharing agreement with AT&T Corp., said agreement to be substantially in conformance with the critical terms and financial obligations described in the attached draft agreement.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
