WHEREAS, the City/non-profit partnership at CMC now serves almost 1000 youth and adult participants a week in music classes and activities, and hosts over 4,500 attendees at more than 150 diverse, free and low-cost musical performances each year; and

WHEREAS, the Community Music Center Inc. has commissioned a book to be written about the history of the Community Music Center, due to be released June 7, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the students, instructors, alumni and volunteers of the Community Music Center celebrate the 60th anniversary with a performance festival and community event at Reed College on June 7, 2015
