

**ORDINANCE No. 187159**

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation, Metro, Multnomah County, Washington County and Clackamas County for preparing a Regional Over-Dimensional Truck Route Study (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Council passed Ordinance No. 180132 on May 10, 2006 adopting the Portland Freight Master Plan which recommends that a strategy be developed for over-dimensional truck routes throughout the city as an implementing action.
2. The Portland Bureau of Transportation recognize that a more effective strategy for planning over-dimensional truck routes is at the regional level to account for inter-jurisdictional movements and proposed that Metro include a Regional Over-Dimension Truck Route Study into their Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP).
3. In May 2014, Metro adopted the FY 2013-15 Unified Planning Work Program which includes the preparation of the Regional Over-Dimensional Truck Route Study and the City of Portland, Washington County and Clackamas County as partner agencies.
4. In December 2014, the Metro Council approved \$125,000 in Regional Flexible Funds for preparing a Regional Over-Dimensional Truck Route Study.
5. The required local match contribution of \$14,306.82 will be divided evenly between the City of Portland, Washington County and Clackamas County and be provided by utilizing in-kind services. The City of Portland's local match contribution of \$4,768.94 will be provided by funds from FY 14/15 General Transportation Revenues (GTR) of the Portland Bureau of Transportation in the form of salary, benefits and materials and services. The City of Portland will serve as the project manager and be reimbursed \$10,000 for project management services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation, Metro, Multnomah County, Washington County and Clackamas County for preparing a Regional Over-Dimensional Truck Route Study in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
