

Ordinance No. 20.

An Ordinance to authorize and require the Grading & Planking of Front Street between A & C Streets.

Sec 1st. The people of the City of Portland, do ordain as follows — That the owners of all lots in Front Street, between A and C Streets, be and are hereby required at their own expense on or before the 15th day of October next ensuing, to grade and plank or timber thirty (30) feet in width of Front Street next each of their respective lots, the said grading and planking to consist of a side-walk nine (9) feet in width and the remaining twentyone (21) feet, to be a substantial Plank or Timber road for Wagons

Sec 2^d. That all plank or timber used in planking said streets shall equal or exceed three (3) inches in thickness, and shall be square edges. — And all plank used in the construction of side-walks shall equal or exceed two (2) inches in thickness

and shall have square edges. Provided. That nothing in this Ordinance shall be constructed so as to prevent the owners of any lots from laying a good and substantial brick sidewalk in front of their property.

Sect 3^d. That all the work provided for in this ordinance shall be done under the direction and supervision of the Street Commissioner of the City of Portland.

Section 4th. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force in fifteen days after its approval by the Mayor.
