

ORDINANCE NO. 7181.

An Ordinance authorizing and directing a contract with the Albina Light and Water Company for Electric Lights in the City.

THE CITY OF PORTLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1;- That the Committee on Ways and Means of the Common Council of the City of Portland, are hereby empowered and directed to enter into a contract for and on behalf of the City of Portland, with the Albina Light and Water Company, for lighting the Streets and Avenues of the City of Portland for a period of two (2) years from the 6th day of July A.D. 1891, the said Albina Light and Water Company to erect, maintain and light such number of electric arc lamps, and of incandescent electric lamps respectively, and at such points in the streets Avenues and Public Grounds of said City as such Council shall, during said terms, from time to time, order and designate, provided, however, that the said Albina Light and Water Company shall not be required to erect, maintain or light any arc lamp at a greater distance than a quarter of a mile from some other arc lamp, not to erect, maintain or light any incandescent lamp at a greater distance than two blocks from some other incandescent lamp supplied under such contract, and that the number of neither arc nor incandescent lamps, shall during said term, be reduced after any number of such lamps respectively shall have been ordered and designated. X

SECTION 2;- That each of the arc lamps provided for in said contract shall not be less than two Thousand candle power, and each of the incandescent lights shall not be of less than twenty candle power and all of said lamps shall be lighted every night from twilight of the evening to daylight of the morning following.

SECTION 3;- The City of Portland shall pay the said Albina Light and Water Company for said Lighting, as follows:

For each arc light, twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) per month, from and during one year from the 6th day of July 1891, and ten (\$10.) dollars per month for each such arc light for the remainder of the said term of two years and for each incandescent light so ordered and designated, the sum of two dollars and seventy five cents (\$2.75) per month.

Payments for said lights shall be made to said Albina Light and Water Company by the said City of Portland, monthly by Warrants on the Treasurer of said City.

SECTION 4;- Said Contract shall contain a provision to the effect that for any failure to light or keep lighted during the hours herein required, any lamps in said contract mentioned caused by the negligence or carelessness of the Albina Light and Water Company it shall forfeit and pay therefor a sum equal to one-tenth of the monthly contract price of lighting such lamps, for each and every night of such failure, but if such failure is not caused by the negligence or carelessness of said Company, it shall not be required to pay the penalty above mentioned, but it shall not receive any pay for lighting such lamp or lamps, during the continuance of such failure.

SECTION 5;- Said Albina Light and Water Company, shall enter into a good and sufficient undertaking in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000) Dollars with one or more sureties to be approved by the Mayor conditioned that the said Company will on its part, perform all the terms of said contract by it or them to be performed, according to the terms thereof, PROVIDED, that this Ordinance and said Contract shall relate to lights and Street Lighting only in that portion of the City of Portland comprised within the former limits of the City of Albina.
