

Ordinance 4300

An Ordinance making an appropriation out of the General fund for Relief of Louis Eppinger.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows

Section 1 That the sum of Forty one $\frac{66}{100}$ dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the general fund for the relief of Louis Eppinger being rebate on unexpired license for Saloon Corner first and A. Sts.

Section 2 The auditor and Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on above fund in favor of Louis Eppinger for the sum of Forty one $\frac{66}{100}$ dollars
