Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of this Agreement is to effectively administer the applicable terms and conditions contained in Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21), a federal-aid program of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).

This legislation maximizes the utilization of commercial vehicle, driver and cargo inspection resources; avoids duplication of effort; expands the number of inspections performed; advances uniformity of inspections; and minimizes delays.

The State of Oregon, Department of Transportation (ODOT) will train or retrain Portland Police Officers who perform commercial vehicle inspections. The Police Bureau will continue to perform commercial vehicle, driver and cargo inspections and ensure that all personnel who engage in such inspections are trained and certified by ODOT.
