7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The Bureau of Human Resources is submitting the attached ordinance which adjusts the compensation rates for nonrepresented classifications and Elected Officials. The adjustments will be 2.1% and will be effective on July 1, 2015. These adjustments are consistent with the City's total compensation policy for all city employees. The following groups of represented employees have a July 1, 2015 cost of living adjustment of 2.1%: District Council of Trade Unions (DCTU), City of Portland Professional Employees Association (COPPEA), Portland Police Association (PPA), Bureau of Emergency Communications (BOEC), Recreation Employees (Municipal Employees Local 483), Portland Fire Fighters' Association (PFFA) and Seasonal Maintenance Workers (Laborer's Local 483). Portland Police Commanding Officers Association (PPCOA) and AFSCME Housing are currently bargaining.

A statement has been included in the ordinance which allows flexibility for the Mayor and individual Commissioners to freeze their salaries at their current rate upon their request.

8. FINANCIAL IMPACT

The appropriation for this increase is in the General Fund set-aside and non-general fund bureaus have provided for this adjustment in their compensation contingency. There is no cost for the 2014-15 fiscal year. The cost for the 2015-16 fiscal year is \$3,037,000 with \$1,372,000 in the General Fund and the remaining \$1,665,000 for non-general fund bureaus.

I recommend that the Mayor and City Council approve this ordinance.
