ORDINANCE No. 187177

* Accept three federal grants totaling \$703,876 from the Department of Housing and Urban Development for Continuum of Care planning, the administration of the regional Homeless Management Information System, and OTIS supportive housing programs (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Through Ordinance 186856, The Council authorized the Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) to apply to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for three grants, totaling \$703,876, including \$163,700 for the Continuum of Care (CoC) planning grant, \$245,666 for the administration of the regional Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) and \$294,510 OTIS supportive housing programs. PHB applied for those grants on October 29, 2014; and
- 2. HUD has notified the City of Portland that it will award three grants for the Continuum of Care in the amount of \$703,876.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland the three grants from HUD in the amount of \$703,876 and to execute the associated grant agreements in a form similar to Exhibit A.
- b. PHB and the Office of Management and Finance Grants Office are authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant applications, grant agreements or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- c. The Director of PHB of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by HUD the executed grant agreements, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the grant agreement for HMIS must be executed and funds drawn prior to close of City's fiscal year. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
