

Ordinance No. 19964.

An Ordinance vacating all that portion of Twentieth street lying south of the south line of Terrace Road, in said City, ~~extended in a~~ straight line easterly to the west line of lot four (4) in block one hundred and four (104), in Grover's Addition to the City of Portland, and the alley way ten (10) feet in width, beginning at a point one hundred (100) feet south of the south line of Spring street, in the line of said Twentieth street, and extending southerly to Terrace Drive, now changed to Elizabeth street, said alley way being in the center of said Twentieth street, were said street extended southerly from its present terminus.

Whereas, due and legal notice was given by advertisement thereof for four successive weeks, to wit: from Monday, September 28, 1908, to Monday, October 26, 1908, both days inclusive, in the City official newspaper of the City of Portland, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: The Portland Daily Abstract, published in said City, which said notice appeared in the issues of said newspaper published on September 28, 1908; October 5, 1908; October 12, 1908; October 19, 1908 and October 26, 1908; that on the 28th day of October, 1908, at a regular meeting of the Council of said City of Portland, to be held on said day, a petition would be presented to said Council, praying for the vacation of all that portion of Twentieth street, lying and situate south of the south line of Terrace Road, in said City, extended in a straight line easterly to the west line of lot four (4) in block one hundred and four (104) in Grover's Addition to the City of Portland, and also the alley way ten (10) feet in width beginning at a point one hundred (100) feet south of the south line of Spring street and ex-

tended southerly to Terrace Drive, now changed to Elizabeth street, said alley way being in what would be the center ten (10) feet of said Twentieth street were said street extended southerly from its present terminus: and

Whereas, said petition was duly presented to the Council on said day named in said notice, which said petition duly set forth a description of the portion of Twentieth street and the said alley way sought to be vacated, and the reasons therefor: and

Whereas, there was filed in the office of the Auditor with said petition, and as a basis for such vacation, and as a basis for granting the prayer of said petition, the consent of the owners in fee simple of over two thirds of the real property fronting on both sides of that portion of said street and said alley way sought to be vacated, as well as the extension of said frontage, in accordance with Section 362 of the Charter of the City of Portland, which consent was duly acknowledged by the Owners of said real property so fronting upon said street and alley way sought to be vacated, before the officer required by said Charter; and

Whereas, the Council upon the presentation of said petition and the filing of the proof of publication of said notice, did fix the regular meeting of the Council, on Wednesday, the 25th day of November, 1908, at the regular meeting place in the Council Chamber, at the City Hall, in Portland, Oregon, for the hearing of said petition and of the objections thereto: and

Whereas the same was regularly continued from time to time to this day; and

Whereas, said Council has ascertained and determined, and does hereby ascertain and determine, and caused and does hereby cause to be made a matter of record, that all of the herein-

before recited acts and things have been done, and that the consent of the owners of the requisite number of front feet has been duly obtained and that the public interests would not be prejudiced by the vacation of that portion of Twentieth street and said alley way herein before described and set forth: and

Whereas, all objections to the vacation of said described portion of Twentieth street and said alley way have been withdrawn; now, therefore,

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That all that portion of Twentieth street lying and situate to the south of the south line of Terrace Road, in said City of Portland, extended in a straight line easterly to the west line of lot four (4) in block one hundred and four (104) in Grover's Addition to the City of Portland, and also the alley way ten (10) feet in width, beginning at a point one hundred (100) feet south of the south line of Spring street and extended southerly to Terrace Drive, now changed to Elizabeth street, said alley way being in what would be the center ten (10) feet of said Twentieth street, were said street extended southerly from its present terminus, be and the same is hereby vacated, reserving however, to the City of Portland, the right and easement to lay, maintain and operate a water pipe along and over said portion of said street and alley way so vacated, and to enter thereon to do all necessary work to carry out the rights reserved in said vacation.
