

An Ordinance making an appropriation out of the Special Bridge Fund to provide for the payment of land to be used for approaches to a bridge to be constructed across Sullivan Gulch at East Twenty-first Street, and authorizing the Mayor and Auditor to purchase such land, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the sum of ten thousand dollars, (\$10,000.00), be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Special Bridge Fund to provide for the payment of property to be used for approaches to a bridge to be constructed across Sullivan Gulch at East Twenty-first Street.

Section 2. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to purchase, and draw warrants on the Special Bridge Fund in payment thereof, the following described property:

West one-half of Block 39, Sullivan's Addition to East Portland;

Lots 5 and 6, Block 39, Sullivan's Addition to East Portland.

Section 3. Whereas there is an immediate necessity that this ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor, an emergency is hereby declared and said ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Portland for the following reasons: It is necessary to

commence proceedings for the construction of said bridge immediately, in order to facilitate travel in that section of the City. Therefore this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
