ORDINANCE No. 187180

* Accept and appropriate an additional award in the amount of \$24,000 from Oregon Impact for the 2015 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement program for sworn personnel overtime (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau accepted a grant from Oregon Impact in the amount of \$100,000 for the 2015 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) program on December 10, 2014 with the passing of Ordinance 186919; and
- 2. Oregon Impact has notified the City that it will grant an additional \$24,000 for the 2015 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) program to the Police Bureau; and
- 3. The additional dollars will fund the Police Bureau Traffic Division's direct enforcement in order to reduce impaired driving and improve traffic safety; and
- 4. Oregon Impact will reimburse the City a new maximum of \$124,000 for sworn personnel overtime hours worked on the 2015 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) program. The reimbursement rate is \$60.00 per hour; and
- 5. The local match may include any agency resources used to support the overtime activity, including scheduling and report compilation, as well as straight-time enforcement. Local match shall be provided from City funds in the form of Traffic Division straight time hours in support of DUII enforcement in the Police Bureau's existing General Fund appropriation. The estimated minimum match of the additional dollars is \$31,424; and
- 6. The grant period remains as October 1, 2014, through September 30, 2015; and
- 7. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant with these additional dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland additional dollars from Oregon Impact for the 2015 DUII Traffic Safety and High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) program grant in the amount of \$24,000.

b. The FY 2014-15 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund - 217 Business Area - PL Bureau Program Expenses - \$24,000

The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized c. to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant with these additional dollars. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
