ORDINANCE No. 187186

*Authorize \$1,618,079 for grant agreements to be divided among the five non-profit neighborhood District Coalitions to support Neighborhood Associations and community engagement activities from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2020. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. These grant agreements provide financial and limited staff resources from the City of Portland Office of Neighborhood Involvement (ONI) to the five recognized District Coalitions per City Code 3.96 to provide such services by which the people of the City of Portland may effectively participate in civic affairs and work to improve the livability and character of their Neighborhoods and the City.
- 2. The five non-profit neighborhood District Coalitions are critical partners in helping ONI achieve its three primary community engagement goals—originally developed by the "Community Connect: Five-year Plan to Increase Community Involvement in Portland," adopted by the City Council on February 27, 2008. These three goals include:
 - Increasing the number and diversity of people who are involved and volunteer in their communities and neighborhoods.
 - Strengthening neighborhood and community capacity to build identity, skills, relationships and partnerships.
 - Increasing community and neighborhood impact on public decisions.
- 3. These grant agreements also shall comply with City Policy ADM-4.03 Standards for Neighborhood Associations, District Coalitions, Business District Associations and the Office of Neighborhood Involvement.
- 4. The term of these grants agreements is five years, with an option to extend for an additional five years.
- 5. A total of \$1,618,079 in General Fund dollars is allocated in the Office of Neighborhood Involvement FY 2015-16 adopted budget for distribution of these grants as part of ONI's Neighborhood Program.
- 6. Grant funds should be allocated to the Grantees in the future for the term of these grant agreements without the need for an additional ordinance authorizing this expenditure, provided funds for this purpose are allocated in a City budget adopted by City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a) The Director of the Office of Neighborhood Involvement and the City Auditor are authorized to execute grant agreements on behalf of the City to the five non-profit neighborhood District Coalitions in a form substantially in accordance with Exhibits A(1), A(2), A(3), A(4), A(5) in the amounts below:

- b) The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay the grant funds from the General Fund.
- c) The Office of Neighborhood Involvement is authorized to issue grants to the five non-profit neighborhood District Coalitions to support to support Neighborhood Associations, diverse community involvement, and community engagement activities in the District Coalition's designated target area in the City of Portland in the amount of \$1,618,079 in FY 2015-16 with future year funding based on the adopted budget for that year.
- d) Amendments to the grant agreements may be agreed to and *executed* by the Director of the Office of Neighborhood Involvement or her/his designee.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in funding would interrupt the ability of the five non-profit neighborhood District Coalitions to provide civic engagement services to their communities; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
