

ORDINANCE No. 187190

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Clackamas Fire District #1 to donate three Zoll defibrillators (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Oregon Revised Statute 190.010 authorizes a unit of local government to enter into a written agreement with any other unit of local government.
2. Portland City Code (PCC) 5.36.010.5.b, authorizes the donation of surplus personal property to other public agencies and states that donations with a current market value of more than \$5,000 must be approved by Council.
3. On November 14, 2012, Council passed ordinance 185731, accepting and appropriating the Fiscal Year 2011 Metropolitan Medical Response System Grant (MMRS), CFDA # 97.071 grant award of \$267,609, from the Oregon Military Department, Office of Emergency Management.
4. Among other emergency medical response items Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) acquired three (3) Zoll X Series monitor/defibrillator (defibrillators) systems.
5. Federal and State rules provide for the transfer of grant-funded equipment.
6. Clackamas Fire District #1 (CFD1) is an MMRS regional partner, and therefore eligible to receive transferred equipment, and has a need for the emergency medical response equipment to enhance emergency capability.
7. CFD1 agrees to abide by all Homeland Security Program rules for use, maintenance, tracking and disposal of the three (3) Zoll X Series Monitor/Defibrillator systems and hold harmless, defend and indemnify the City of Portland, its officers, agents and employees from any claims, demands, actions and suits arising from the use of the defibrillators.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is hereby authorized to execute an agreement in substantially the same form as attached hereto as Exhibit 1, with Clackamas Fire District #1.
- b. Portland Fire & Rescue is authorized to donate three Zoll defibrillators to Clackamas Fire District #1.
