

**IMPACT STATEMENT**

**Legislation title:** Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Clackamas Fire District #1 to donate three Zoll defibrillators (Ordinance)

**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

On November 14, 2012, Council passed Ordinance #185732, accepting and appropriating the Fiscal Year 2011 Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) grant. As part of the grant program Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) purchased three Zoll defibrillators. It was determined that regional MMRS partner Clackamas Fire District 1 (CFD1) was in need of these defibrillators to improve their medical response. In order to complete the grant documentation, PF&R is required to have an Intergovernmental Agreement with CFD1 which transfers the defibrillators and the reporting requirements to CFD1.

**Financial and budgetary impacts:**

The three defibrillators were purchased with grant funds, therefore there are no financial or budgetary impacts related to this legislation. There are no changes in staffing related to this legislation

**Community impacts and community involvement:**

Because this grant program is for the Portland Metropolitan area, it is appropriate that some purchased equipment be used by other MMRS regional partners, especially ones that are PF&R mutual aid partners. The transfer of this equipment ensures that when CFD1 provides mutual aid response in PF&R's jurisdiction, it has the ability to provide advanced life support to our citizens.
