

Ordinance No. 25414

An Ordinance accepting a permit for right of way for the construction of the Insley Avenue trunk sewer.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a permit for a right of way for the construction of the Insley Avenue trunk sewer through the following described property be and is hereby accepted from the Portland Railway, Light and Power Company:

A strip of land 15 feet in width, the center line of which is described as follows: Commencing at the point of intersection of the west line of Milwaukie Street with the center line of Insley Avenue, as laid out and established in Alton Park, an addition to the City of Portland, and thence following a westerly extension of the said center line of Insley Avenue a distance of 1040 feet, more or less, to the low water mark of the Willamette River.

Section 2. That the Auditor of the City of Portland be and is hereby directed to have the permit for a right of way for the construction of the Insley Avenue trunk sewer through the property described in Section 1 of this ordinance placed on record.
