

Ordinance No. 25802.

An Ordinance to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 25434, entitled, "An Ordinance to vacate a portion of Clifton Street," approved by the Mayor, July 5, 1912.

WHEREAS, in the matter of the vacation of a portion of Clifton Street, under the provisions of Ordinance No. 25434, an error was made in the description of the property sought to be vacated; and,

WHEREAS, the published notice of said vacation in the Portland Daily Abstract excepted a strip of land fifteen feet wide in the center of said Clifton Street; therefore,

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 25434, entitled, "An Ordinance to vacate a portion of Clifton Street," approved by the Mayor, July 5, 1912, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. That all of that portion of Clifton Street described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of block 236, City of Portland; and running thence westerly along the south line of said block 236 a distance of 100 feet; thence southerly parallel to the west line of Tenth Street 50 feet to the easterly line of Cardinell Drive; thence southerly along the easterly line of Cardinell Drive 12.06 feet to the south line of Clifton Street; thence easterly along the south line of Clifton Street 93.46 feet to the westerly line of Tenth Street; thence northerly 60 feet to the place of beginning; except a strip of land fifteen (15) feet wide in the center of said Clifton Street;

in the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, and State of Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated, and it is ordered that the vacation herein declared be made a matter of record as provided in Section 364 of the Charter of the City of Portland."
