

Ordinance No. 26461.

An Ordinance granting a permit to Pacific Bridge Company to construct a temporary track on East Salmon Street from Grand Avenue to East 10th Street and on East 9th and East 10th Streets from East Salmon Street to East Yamhill Street.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. That a permit be and is hereby granted to Pacific Bridge Company, a corporation, to construct a temporary track on East Salmon Street from a connection with the present track of the Pacific Bridge Company at the intersection of Grand Avenue and along the north side of said East Salmon Street to the intersection with East 10th Street, and thence along the east side of East 10th Street to the intersection with East Yamhill Street, and also from an intersection with East Salmon Street along the east side of East 9th Street to the intersection with East Yamhill Street: Said track to be used in the filling of certain low lots in Hawthorne Park and the streets abutting upon the same, and the hauling of earth, sand and gravel material for that purpose; said track to be constructed in a manner satisfactory to the City Engineer and to be removed when directed by the Council, and the streets put in proper condition satisfactory to the City Engineer.

Sec. 2. Whereas there is an immediate necessity that this ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the Mayor, an emergency is hereby declared and said ordinance is hereby declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Portland for the following reasons: It is necessary for the health and safety of the people of the City of Portland that all low ground therein be filled

up and drained and all stagnant water thereby removed, and by the permit granted under this ordinance, the Pacific Bridge Company as the contractor will be enabled to carry out a contract for the filling of a large amount of said low ground in the most expeditious and practical manner.

Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its approval by the Mayor.
