

Ordinance No. 29127.

An Ordinance granting a revocable permit to R. R. Thompson Estate to construct a gasoline filling station under the sidewalk in front of lot 8, block 31, City of Portland.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a revocable permit be and is hereby granted to R. R. Thompson Estate to construct a 280-gallon gasoline filling station under the sidewalk in front of building situated on lot 8, block 31, City of Portland, designated as No. 42 Third street.

Section 2. Said gasoline filling station shall be constructed satisfactory to the City Engineer and Fire Marshal of the City of Portland and be removed when so ordered by the Council of said City of Portland, and the sidewalk put in proper condition, and the granting of this permit and the expenditure of money thereunder, shall not create any vested rights in said grantee, or his successors or assigns, and said grantee is prohibited from assigning this permit without the consent of the Council first expressed by ordinance.

Section 3. That the gasoline filling station authorized to be constructed under the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall not be removed without permission therefor being first obtained from the Council and the filing of a bond in the sum of \$250, conditioned that the street will be replaced in proper condition satisfactory to the Commissioner of Public Works.

Section 4. Any person removing the gasoline filling station authorized to be constructed under the provisions of this ordinance without obtaining permission from the Council and filing the bond provided for in Section 3 of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in the Municipal Court, be punished by a fine of not more than \$100 or by imprisonment in the city jail for not more than thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
