

An Ordinance providing for the manner of extending and widening East Morrison Street from a line 75.91 feet east of and parallel to the east line of Garrison's Subdivision in East Portland, Oregon, to the east line of East 20th Street.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That East Morrison Street from a line 75.91 feet east of and parallel to the east line of Garrison's Subdivision in East Portland, Oregon, to the east line of East 20th Street shall be extended and widened as follows, a plan, statement and estimate for which was filed by the City Engineer in the office of the City Auditor on October 12, 1914 and is dated October 9, 1914: extending and widening said street so as to make the south line of said street through block 7, Garrison's Subdivision, coincide with a line drawn from the northeast corner of block 11, Garrison's Subdivision, to a point on the south line of East Morrison Street in Tilton's Addition 7.5 feet west of the northeast corner of lot 18, block 3, Tilton's Addition; the south line east of Garrison's Subdivision to coincide with the present south line of East Morrison Street, and the north line to be as follows: Commencing at a point on the east line of East 20th Street 28.29 feet south of the north line of East Morrison Street extended east; thence, 50 feet distant from and parallel to the south line as described above, southeasterly 99.98 feet; thence on a curve to the left, with a radius of 175 feet, to a point 51 feet north of the south line of East Morrison Street in Tilton's Addition and 75.91 feet east of the east line of Garrison's Subdivision, the particular description of the location thereof and of the property required therefor being as set forth and specified in the Engineer's report, endorsed "Report of City Engineer in the matter of the extension of East Morrison Street, filed October 12, 1914, A. I. Barbur, Auditor of the City of Portland, by W. D. Smith, Deputy".

The probable cost of said proposed extension and widening as estimated by the City Engineer is the sum of \$925.00 for damages and \$75.00 for surveying and advertising and superintendence, making a total of \$1000.00.

A detailed description of the property required for said extension and widening is set forth in the plans, statement and estimate of the City Engineer above specified, reference to which is hereby made.

The boundaries of the district benefited and to be assessed for said extension and widening shall be as follows:

Commencing at the northwest corner of lot 5, block 6, Garrison Subdivision in East Portland, now in the City of Portland, Multnomah County, State of Oregon, and running thence east to the northeast corner of said lot 5; thence southeasterly to the northwest corner of lot 5, block 7, said Garrison's Subdivision; thence east along the north line of said lot 5, block 7, and an easterly extension thereof to a point 200 feet easterly of the east line of said block 7; thence south, parallel to the east line of said block 7, to a point 21 feet north of the north line of East Morrison Street in Tilton's Addition to the City of Portland; thence east, 21 feet north of and parallel to the north line of said East Morrison Street to the west line of East 26th Street; thence south, along the west line of East 26th Street, to a point 69 feet south of the south line of said East Morrison Street; thence west, 69 feet south of and parallel to the south line of said East Morrison Street, to the west line of said Tilton's Addition; thence north to the southeast corner of lot 1, block 1, Central Addition to East Portland; thence west to the southwest corner of said lot 1; thence northwest to the south-

east corner of lot 4, block 11, Garrison's subdivision in East
Portland; thence west to the southwest corner of lot 5, said
block 11; thence north to the place of beginning.
