On February 25, 2015 City Council approved Ordinance 187030 establishing the Equitable Contracting and Purchasing Commission. Commission will review City wide reports and data, as well as data and information produced by agencies and collected by the Chief Procurement Officer regarding City performance concerning increasing minorities and women on City contracts, increase minorities and women in the workforce on City projects, and demonstrate effective outcomes beneficial to minorities and to women.
