ORDINANCE No. 187203

*Accept an Intergovernmental Grant Agreement with Metro of \$20,000 for the Deconstruction Assessment Pilot Project Phase II in FY 2014-2016 to promote and encourage reuse and recycling of demolition building materials (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland Bureau of Planning and Sustainability's Green Building Program is partnering with Metro to develop a second phase of a Deconstruction Assessment Tool to promote and encourage reuse and recycling of building materials associated with demolition.
- 2. On May 7, 2014, the first phase of this project was approved by Ordinance #186551.
- 3. The Green Building Program supplies technical assistance, educational programs, and tours related to commercial and residential projects in Portland that demonstrate methods and innovations in reducing construction impacts, conserving natural resources, and encouraging reduction, reuse, and recycling of materials.
- 4. Metro proposes to provide financial support for the City's program's because they are consistent with its solid waste and recycling objectives in the areas of construction and demolition debris recycling and initiatives for construction and demolition waste reduction.
- 5. The City of Portland is eligible to receive \$20,000 in FY 14-15 to support the second phase of the Deconstruction Assessment Pilot Project.
- 6. No City match is required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental grant agreement with Metro #933508, City of Portland #30004674 in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit 1.
- b. The FY 14-15 budget is \$0 and FY 2015-16 budget of \$20,000 will be appropriated in Fall BuMP.
- c. The Office of Management and Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, or requests for reimbursements from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

d. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Metro provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to forward funds for services to continue work that benefits the City. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


