Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This ordinance will establish a 9-member voting Commission appointed by the Mayor. The Commission shall include minorities and women contractors, and stakeholders with experience in diversity contracting. The Mayor shall designate a City employee to Chair the commission, and has selected Bryant Enge, Director of the Bureau of Internal Business Services.

The Commission Duties and Purpose shall be to review City wide reports and data, as well as data and information produced by agencies and collected by the Chief Procurement Officer regarding City performance concerning increasing minorities and women on City contracts, increase minorities and women in the workforce on City projects, and demonstrate effective outcomes beneficial to minorities and to women. The Commission will submit periodic reports on utilization to the Council, including data on City spending and contract awards to minority and women owned business and provide feedback on the effectiveness of the City's minority and women owned business inclusion policies, processes and programs.
