ORDINANCE No. 187232

*Pay claim of Peter Bach in the sum of \$16,526 involving Portland Bureau of Transportation. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Peter Bach has filed a property damage claim against the City for damages suffered in a sewer backup on March 26, 2015 involving the Portland Bureau of Transportation (Maintenance).
- 2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$16,526.30, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney. Risk Management has advanced the sum of \$5,000 to the claimant, so the total check amount to be paid by this Ordinance is \$11,526.30.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$11,526.30 made payable to Peter Bach. (Total payment, including \$5,000 advance previously paid, is \$16,526.30).
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
