## ORDINANCE No. 187235

\*Authorize a Master Intergovernmental Agreement between the Bureau of Technology Services and the Mt. Hood Cable Regulatory Commission to provide for reimbursement of the Bureau of Technology Services capital costs for approved work performed on the Institutional Network. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Mt. Hood Cable Regulatory Commission (MHCRC) collects PEG/Institutional Network (I-Net) fees under cable services franchise agreements to, among other purposes, fund capital costs of local governments' and educational institutions' use of the I-Net.
- 2. BTS maintains and operates the I-Net and provides technical support and manages projects for the maintenance and enhancement of the I-Net. Such projects require upgrading and or installing network hardware to accommodate requests from the I-Net stakeholders. I-Net related work and services are provided on a cost reimbursement basis.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor is authorized to sign the Master Intergovernmental Agreement with MHCRC in substantial conformance with the one attached as Exhibit A and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the contract, therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
