

An Ordinance taking over Nicolai street from the west line of Twenty-sixth street to the westerly line of Industrial Center, extended, as a city street, and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the County Court of Multnomah County, Oregon, has notified the City of Portland that said court has decreed that jurisdiction over Nicolai street, a county road, from the west line of Twenty-sixth street to the westerly line of Industrial Center, extended, be terminated, and that said street be surrendered to the City of Portland as and for a public street; now, therefore,

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Nicolai street, now a county road, from the west line of Twenty-sixth street to the westerly line of Industrial Center, extended, be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland as and for a city street.

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist in this: Nicolai street is in a bad condition and it is desired that proceedings be commenced immediately providing for the improvement thereof; therefore this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
