

Ordinance No. 31077.

An Ordinance providing for the changing of the names of certain streets in the City of Portland.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the names of the streets within the corporate limits of the City of Portland be and the same are hereby changed as provided in Section 3 of this Ordinance and the said streets shall hereafter be known by the names as provided in said section.

Section 2: The tabular headings in Section 3 of this ordinance are hereby made a part of and understood to fully describe and designate the name changes enumerated under them.

Section 3: That the following streets as given in the first column located as described in the second column shall be changed and hereafter known by the respective, or corresponding names, as given in the third column:

Present, or old Name of Street	Location	Name changed to
Short Street	from Gideon Street on the south to Brooklyn Street on the north	Brooklyn Street

Section 4: Nothing contained in this ordinance shall in any way affect the validity of any proceedings now pending for the improvement, opening, laying-out, extending or widening of any of the streets above mentioned, or for the changing or establishing of grades thereon, but such proceedings shall continue and be completed as though the names of such streets had not been changed.
