## ORDINANCE No. 187248

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the 20s Bikeway Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The 20s Bikeway Project will improve a major north-south bicycle route identified in the Portland Bicycle Master Plan for 2030, adopted by City Council in 2010 (Resolution No 36763).
- 2. In 2013, the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) received \$2,338,000 in federal grant funding from the Regional Flexible Funds Program to design and construct the project.
- 3. Additional funding for the project comes from PBOT's System Development Charge Program.
- 4. Project design is completed and now PBOT is proceeding with bidding the project for construction.
- 5. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 15/16 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
- 6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate, as plans, specifications, and estimates are now completed and the project is ready for bidding.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00338 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
