### Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Safety Division notified the City that it will award a grant in the amount of \$221,588, to be reimbursed during the grant period of July 1, 2015 – June 30, 2017. The ODOT project will fund overtime for the Police Bureau Traffic Division to provide high visibility and high contact enforcement efforts while on patrol in identified ODOT work zones.

ODOT reimburses officer overtime at a rate of \$59.50 per hour and sergeant overtime at a rate of \$68.40 per hour for activities specified toward this grant program. Local match in the amount of \$43,058 is required by matching straight-time hours at a rate of \$43.00 per hour, which will be funded by existing bureau General Fund appropriations during the grant period.

This ordinance authorizes application to and acceptance of this award.

# Financial and budgetary impacts:

The total grant award is \$221,588, which will be reimbursed during fiscal years 2015-17. At this time, the City will appropriate \$100,000 into the Grant Fund. This grant comes with a match obligation of \$43,058 which will be funded by the Police Bureau's General Fund appropriation over the course of the grant period.

# Community impacts and community involvement:

There are no legal or controversial issues. There is no voluntary citizen participation. There are no links to current City policies. Traffic Division personnel may work with additional city and county police agencies, as well as ODOT, while working on the grant program items.
