ORDINANCE No. 187255

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Portland State University for Citywide on-call sustainable operations technical assistance for a not to exceed amount of \$150,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council Finds:

- 1. The City's Sustainable City Principles, Climate Action Plan, 2030 Environmental Performance Objectives, Sustainable Procurement Policy, and related City sustainability policies direct City bureaus and offices to seek continuous improvement in resource efficiency, toxics use reduction, waste reduction, and follow other known sustainable operations best practices.
- 2. Portland State University's Community Environmental Services (PSU CES) program is a research and service unit that provides high-quality research, technical assistance, and education outreach services. The City and PSU CES have successfully worked together on previous sustainable operations-related projects.
- 3. The initiation of this IGA PSU CES will assist the City in establishing and implementing sustainable operations best practices as bureaus work towards meeting the City's 2030 Environmental Performance Objectives. The types of projects this IGA will be used for include: material assessments, a supply chain greenhouse gas inventory, as well as projects related to waste reduction, energy and water efficiency, sustainable procurement and toxics reduction. In return, the City will provide funding to PSU CES for the cost of the service at a sum not to exceed \$150,000.00 for on-call sustainable operations technical assistance. This IGA will expire June 30, 2018 unless otherwise amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) is authorized to execute, amend and extend a threeyear IGA with Portland State University for the purpose described in Section 1 for a not to exceed amount of \$150,000, provided it has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists as the City needs to act promptly to meet current project and budget deadlines and ensure timely implementation of sustainable best practices; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and in effect after its passage by Council.
