

ORDINANCE No. 187256

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metropolitan Service District for Portland Fire & Rescue emergency response vehicles computerized mapping data, not to exceed \$10,000 per year (Ordinance; Contract No. 30004638)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City and Metropolitan Service District (Metro) find it mutually beneficial for both governments to cooperate in mapping the metropolitan area in order to enhance the prompt delivery of emergency response services.
2. Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) has an on-going need to have current mapping and system information available in electronic format for use in its emergency response apparatus.
3. Metro has the current ability and capacity to maintain the components of a mapping and data system for the City.
4. This Agreement has no termination date, requires annual review and may be terminated by either party upon 10 days written notice.
5. PF&R has sufficient resources in its FY 2015-16 budget and anticipates sufficient resources in its future budgets to allow for these costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Fire Chief is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Metropolitan Service District for the maintenance of a computerized mapping system for use in emergency response vehicles for Portland Fire & Rescue, substantially in accordance with the terms and conditions as shown in Exhibit A, attached hereto, not to exceed \$10,000 per fiscal year.
