ORDINANCE No. 1872 6 6

Authorize the Bureau of Environmental Services to execute a settlement agreement with Bruce Ankarberg as part of the Luther Road Habitat Restoration Project No. E06947 for \$27,989. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In 2014, the Bureau of Environmental Services constructed the Luther Road Habitat Restoration Project to protect the Lents Trunk Sewer, treat stormwater discharges, restore a portion of Johnson Creek and its floodplain, improve stream habitat and water quality, protect natural areas and create a needed community resource.
- 2. The Luther Road Habitat Restoration Project required the acquisition of a Temporary Access Easement (the "Easement") from Bruce Ankarberg in order to complete the project. The Easement is attached hereto as Exhibit 1.
- 3. Section I of the Easement states that the City would complete a 2-inch grind and overlay over Mr. Ankarberg's private roadway within the area comprising the Easement following the City's use of said roadway by construction vehicles.
- 4. In lieu of the City completing the grind and overlay work, the City has agreed to pay Mr. Ankarberg a sum of money as identified in the settlement agreement attached as Exhibit 2 (the "Agreement").
- 5. The estimated cost is \$27,989. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2014-2015 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services Project E06947, Account No. 549000 (temporary non-asset).

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services, or his designee, is authorized to execute the Agreement substantially in the form of the attached Exhibit 2 with Bruce Ankarberg, for the purpose described in Section 1, and to amend it, provided that such amendment does not result in an increase of the established cost identified herein.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
