

Ordinance No. 2115

An Ordinance making an appropriation out of the Water Fund, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Water Fund to provide for the maintenance of fountains.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: It is necessary that this ordinance become effective immediately in order that the amount appropriated in Section 1 hereof may be available for immediate use; therefore an emergency is hereby declared, and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
