

ORDINANCE NO.

An Ordinance providing for the cancellation of appropriation for maintenance of fountains and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the maintenance of fountains has been transferred to the Bureau of Water Works, and

WHEREAS, the unexpended balance, five hundred dollars (\$500.00), in the General Fund applicable to the maintenance of fountains has been transferred to the Water Fund, therefore

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00), appropriated under the provisions of Ordinance No. 32338, as amended by Ordinance No. 33137, be and the same is hereby canceled for the reason that the maintenance of fountains has been transferred to the Bureau of Water Works.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that the proper entries may be made immediately in the financial books and confusion avoided it is necessary that this ordinance become effective immediately, therefore an emergency is hereby declared and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
