

Ordinance No. 32948

An Ordinance to amend Section 7 of Ordinance No. 310 of the City of East Portland, as amended, providing for the discontinuance of a passenger depot at East Hoyt Street

The City of Portland does ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 7 of Ordinance No. 310 entitled "An Ordinance authorizing the Oregon Railway & Navigation Company to lay a railway track and run cars over the same within the City of East Portland", passed by the Board of Trustees of said city September 13, 1881, as amended by Ordinance No. 325 of said City of East Portland and as further amended by Ordinance No. 26400 of the City of Portland, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Section 7. The Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company, as successor to Oregon Railway & Navigation Company, shall continue to maintain within the district comprising the City of East Portland in the year 1881 at a point south of what was then known as Salem Street, now East Hoyt Street, a suitable freight depot, but the obligation heretofore existing to maintain a passenger depot at said point and within said district is hereby terminated."
