Ordinance No. **32950**

An Ordinance granting to the Trustees of The David Campbell Memorial and Medal Fund the privilege of erecting and maintaining a monument on the triangular tract of land at 19th, Chapman and Alder Streets, Portland, Oregon, and granting control of said tract of land to said Trustees.

WHEREAS, the trustees of the David Campbell Memorial and Medal Fund are considering the erection of a monument to be built of some durable material and of artistic design in commemoration of the heroism of the late David Campbell, and as a visible evidence of the City's appreciation of exalted service and self sacrifice; and,

WHEREAS, the construction of such monument will be of lasting benefit to the City in creating high ideals in the minds of the youth of our city, therefore,

The City of Portland Does Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby granted to the Trustees of The David Campbell Memorial and Medal Fund the right and privilege to construct, erect and permanently maintain a monument and for such purpose, the right to control the plot in the safety zone in which said monument will be located, as a memorial to David Campbell, which monument shall be of bronze on a suitable granite base; said monument to be located on that certain triangular shaped tract of land formed by the intersection of 19th Street, Chapman Street and Alder Street, and more particularly described as follows; Beginning at a point which is the intersection of the south line of Alder Street, extended westerly, and a line 6 feet easterly of the westerly line of Chapman Street, extended northerly, which point is on the face of the present constructed curb, thence southerly along the present curb 6 feet easterly from and parallel to the westerly property line of Chapman Street 57 85 feet; thence along present curb on a curve to the right having a radius of 8 feet and a central angle of 149° 28', a distance of 30 87 feet; thence northwesterly along present curb and tangent to the last above mentioned curve 66 40 feet; thence along the present curb on a curve to the right having a radius of 10 feet and a central angle of 130° 36' a distance of 31 05 feet; thence easterly along present curb and tangent to the last above mentioned curve 29 03 feet; thence along present curb on a curve to the right having a radius of 12 feet and a central angle of 57° 54' a distance of 13 23 feet to the place of beginning.
