An Ordinance granting to the Trustees of The David Campbell Memorial and Medal Fund the pravilege of erecting and asintaining a monment on the triangular stragt of land at 19th, Chaptan and Alder Streets, Fortland, Oregon, and granfing control of said trait of land to said. Trustsea

WHENEAS, the equatees of the Lavid Compbell Meantle, and Wedal Fund are considering the erection of a monument to be built of some durable material and of artistic design in commemoration of the heroism of the late David Comphell, and was a visible evidance of the City a appreciation of exalted service and self rac-Tifice: and

THEREAS, the construction of such monoment will be of leate ing benefit to the City in creating high ideals in the minds of the youth of our city, therefore,

The Dity of Portland Does Ordain as Sollews:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby granted to the Trueters of The David Campbell Memorial and Medal Fund the right and privilege to construct, erest and permanently maintain a mornion and for such purpose, the right to control the plot in the easity some in which said monument will be located, as a memorial to hav id Campbell, which monument shall be of bronze on a suitable grant ite base; said monument to be located on that certain triunsular. chaped tract of land formed by the intersection of 19th Street; Chapman Street and Alder Street, and more particularly described as follows; Beginning at a point which is the intersection of the south line of Alder Street, extended westerly, and a line 6 feet sasterly of the westerly line of Chapman Street, extended northerly which point is on the face of the present constructed carb, thence southerly along the present durb 6 feet emaintly from and parell ol to the westerly property line of Chapean Street 57 86 feet and thence along present ourb on a curve to the right having a recknown, 8 lest and a central angle of 1499 28), a distance of 25 27 feet; thence northwesterly along present ourb and tangent to the last above mentioned curve 68 40 feet; thence along the present ours on a curve to the right having a radius of 10 feet and a central angle of 180° 38° a distance of 81 Of feet; thence east erly along present ourb and tangent to the last above mentioned ourve to Direct; thence along present burb on a curve to the Might having a radius of 12 feet and a central angle of 50 to 100 to cause of 18 20 feat to the place of beginning.
