

Ordinance No. _____

An ordinance accepting certain property for street purpose.

WHEREAS, the owners of the property lying adjacent to the west side of Block 38, Caruthers Addition, have purchased a strip of land 12 feet in width for the purpose of extending Park street to a connection with Lincoln street; and,

WHEREAS, said property, recorded in Book 792, Pages 236 and 237 of the deed records of Multnomah County, described said property; and,

WHEREAS, said property was purchased for a public thoroughfare and the purchasers desire the same to be accepted by the City of Portland for street purposes, now therefore

THE CITY OF PORTLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described property be and is hereby accepted by the City of Portland for street purposes.


Beginning at a point in the southwest corner of Block No. 38 in Caruthers Addition; thence running east 7 feet; thence northerly 100 feet to a point in the northwest corner of Lot 6 in said Block No. 38; thence southerly to the place of beginning, containing 350 square feet, more or less.

Also, commencing where the east line of Park street intersects the division line between the Caruthers and Coffin Donation Land Claim; thence tracing the said line 12 feet west to a point in the said line; thence southerly in a straight line to a point 12 feet north of the south line of Lincoln street and 235 feet west from the west line of Broadway; thence northerly to the northwest corner of Lot 6, Block No. 38 in Caruthers Addition; thence northerly to the place of beginning.
