LED Street Lighting


- Converting 45,000 street lights
 - Implementing in 2 years (December 2016)
 - Largest energy efficiency program in City history
- City purchasing utility owned (PGE) 4,257
 Street Light Only (SLO) poles and circuits (\$1.6M)
 - City agrees to price set by OPUC
 - Purchase of poles has 3.5 year repayment


Street Lighting Retrofit

Review of Schedule

- Dec 2012 Council approved \$18.5M Bond
- May 2013 RFP for street light equipment
- Oct 2013 Studied issue of equity
- Dec 2013 Initial installation of LED
- Mar 2014 Released RFP for installation
- Aug 2015 Reached halfway mark
- Early 2016 Proposal for Historic Lighting
- Dec 2016 Anticipated Completion










Rewarded for Efficiency
