

ORDINANCE NO.

* Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County in the amount of \$60,802 to assist in the transition out of outpatient treatment and supportive housing to chronic offenders identified by the Service Coordination Team (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30004147)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Multnomah County manages a contract with Volunteers of America to provide chronic substance abuse treatment services.
2. Supportive housing and treatment services for chronic offenders identified by the Service Coordination Team have been transferred to a different contractor as of July 1, 2015.
3. Volunteers of America needs an additional \$60,802 to offset personnel costs during the transition out of providing outpatient treatment services for the month of July 2015.
4. It is beneficial to the City and community that this agreement may be authorized as quickly as possible to avoid a delay in payment.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-charge is authorized to amend an agreement between the City and Multnomah County as outlined in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$60,802.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to pay for the contract from the FY 2015-16 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the date for service to commence under the grant agreement will be July 1, 2015. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
