# ORDINANCE No. 187287

\* Amend ordinance authorizing amounts of short-term subordinate urban renewal and redevelopment bonds to reallocate authorized amounts among various urban renewal areas (Ordinance; amend Ordinance No. 185670)

# The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland adopted Ordinance No. 185670 on October 10, 2012, authorizing the issuance during each fiscal year of short-term subordinate urban renewal and redevelopment bonds for its existing urban renewal districts. The authority granted by Ordinance No. 185670 expires on June 30, 2017.
- 2. The City of Portland finds it desirable to amend Ordinance No. 185670 to change the maximum principal amount of short-term subordinate urban renewal and redevelopment bonds that may be issued in each fiscal year for the Central Eastside, Education, Gateway, Interstate, Lents Town Center, River District and Willamette Industrial urban renewal areas.

### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

## a. Authorization of Bonds.

The City hereby amends Section b.1 of Ordinance No. 185670 to authorize the issuance of short-term subordinate urban renewal and redevelopment bonds from time to time through and including June 30, 2017, in multiple series; provided the total principal amount issued for the following urban renewal areas shall not exceed the following amounts per fiscal year:

b. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 185670 shall remain in effect, including the maximum combined \$67,000,000 per fiscal year authorization of short-term subordinate urban renewal and redevelopment bonds and the \$7,000,000 per fiscal year of borrowing authority for the North Macadam Urban Renewal Area.

Section 2. Declaration of Emergency. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that short term subordinate urban renewal and redevelopment bonds may be issued as soon as possible; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
