This Contract was made and entered by and between the Bicycle Transportation Alliance, hereinafter called Contractor, and the City of Portland, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, by and through its duly authorized representatives, hereinafter called City.

- This contract is hereby extended through 6/30/2016.
- Additional work is necessary and includes:
  - Providing bike safety education at 3 middle schools
  - Providing support and coordination to Bikes for Humanity in their efforts to supply qualifying low-income graduates of the Bike Safety Education program with refurbished bikes, helmets, and locks
- Additional compensation is necessary and shall not exceed \$344,000. New not to exceed value of the contract will then be \$1,149,800.

All other terms and conditions shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.


