ORDINANCE No. 187303

* Accept and appropriate a supplemental grant in the amount of \$60,000 from the Oregon Department of Justice and the Oregon High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas program for the purchase of a Chevy Tahoe for a police canine unit (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Police Bureau applied to the Oregon Department of Justice (ODOJ), Oregon High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas (HIDTA) program for grant funding in March 2013, to support the Drugs and Vice Division HIDTA Interdiction Team (HIT) efforts in disrupting and dismantling drug trafficking organizations in Multnomah, Washington, and Clackamas Counties by employing a multi-agency approach to significantly impact drug availability in the area;
- 2. The Oregon Department of Justice was awarded \$2,816,500 by the Office of National Drug Control Policy's HIDTA Program to support initiatives designed to implement the strategy proposed by the Executive Board of the Oregon HIDTA Program and approved by the Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) for the grant period January 1, 2014, through December 31, 2015;
- 3. ODOJ HIDTA has notified the City that it will award a supplemental grant to the Police Bureau Drugs and Vice Division in the amount of \$60,000 and will reimburse the City a maximum of \$60,000 for the purchase of a Chevy Tahoe outfitted for a third police canine unit;
- 4. Per City Resolution 35960, for reporting to Council of new fleet additions, Police would like to add the Chevy Tahoe sports utility vehicle to the fleet;
- 5. There is no required match for this grant;
- 6. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOJ.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City a grant from ODOJ for the Oregon HIDTA program for Portland interdiction efforts in the amount of \$60,000.

b. The FY 2015-16 budget is hereby amended as follows:

<u>GRANTS FUND</u> Fund - 217 Business Area - PL Bureau Program Expenses - \$60,000

PROVIDER FUND Fund - 702 Business Area - MF Bureau Program Expenses - \$60,000

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City any subsequent modifications by ODOJ HIDTA for the HIDTA grant, award number G14OR0002A, provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from ODOJ. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
