ORDINANCE No. 187305

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for the use of U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY 2015 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program funds (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) will provide grant funding under the FY 2015 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program;
- 2. The JAG Program supports the purpose areas of law enforcement programs, prosecution programs, prevention and education programs, and technology improvement programs;
- 3. A condition of the grant program requires the City to serve as applicant and fiscal agent for the disparate municipalities. The City wishes to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multhomah County to obligate agency roles and responsibilities;
- 4. The City will, with DOJ OJP BJA grant funds, reimburse Multnomah County for the cost of all approved program expenses not to exceed \$165,081;
- 5. This agreement shall begin July 1, 2015, and extend through September 30, 2018, or until grant funds are exhausted; and
- 6. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from DOJ.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with this authorization would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from DOJ. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
