ORDINANCE NO. 187310

* Authorize application to Federal Emergency Management Agency for a Pre-Disaster Mitigation grant in the amount of \$500,000 for a residential seismic strengthening program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. City of Portland, Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) has identified funding that can be made available for up to 150 homeowners to reimburse them for 50% of the cost of recommended seismic upgrades.
- 2. Clean Energy Works Oregon has identified qualifying homes that could benefit from seismic upgrades.
- 3. The grant language requires a minimum 25% match. In order to maximize the number of homes seismically strengthened, the City will request homeowners to provide a 50% match. Local match up to \$500,000.00 will be provided by funds from the homeowners towards the cost of the seismic upgrades. PBEM will match \$47,500.00 in administrative and cost benefit analysis funds.
- 4. Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) would make available \$500,000.00 to the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) who would administer these funds locally, with Clean Energy Works Oregon serving as the project manager.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to FEMA for a Pre-Disaster Mitigation (PDM) grant in the amount of \$500,000.00.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications to the PDM grant, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the close date for this grant is August 28th to FEMA and any delay in application for this grant will result in losing the opportunity for funding these activities. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
